**Using Geodatabases for Effective Data Management:  
An Example in Clark County, WA**

Rapidly growing Clark County hired Herrera to help preserve and protect natural resources from the impacts of development, including the effects of stormwater runoff. Herrera inventoried stream features & developed an interactive GIS product that stored the data identifying restoration, enhancement & mitigation projects. A geodatabase was developed that stores data & allows for easy interpretation resulting in 21 capital improvement projects. A 2<sup>nd</sup> database is currently under design to track the lifelines of these projects. Together, both databases will form a comprehensive & interactive system for tracking projects, start to finish.
