The conference will provide an engaging Keynote speaker, technical sessions with CEU's, exhibits of some of the best products in the industry, golf, food, fun and entertainment. Keynote Speaker(s)

Wednesday; John Morgan from Portland, Oregon, will be speaking on “The Leadership Initiative”. Having leadership skills is one thing. Having the motivation, passion, and drive to use them is another. John Morgan will focus on the reasons catalytic leadership is critical to leading our communities and organizations. It will help participants focus on what they can bring to the table, why that is important, and how they can best express that in their leadership roles.

John is a graduate of the University of Arizona having a bachelor's degree in public administration and economics. He serves on the board of the Oregon Innovation Council and is a past member of the Oregon Bioscience Association and the Regence board of directors. John is also a founding board member and secretary of Coalition for Dwarf Advocacy.

Thursday, James Roddey - Director of Communications, American Red Cross, speaking on *“Indian Legends, Ghost Forests and Black Swans: Understanding Great Earthquakes in Oregon”*. James is an award winning author, director, and natural disaster preparedness expert, sometimes known as “The Prophet of Doom.” Prior to joining the Red Cross, James was the Earth Sciences Information Officer for the State of Oregon.

With a background in broadcasting, marketing and geoscience education, James' central message to audiences large and small is one of preparedness and resiliency, so our communities can learn to withstand catastrophic disasters, like earthquakes, tsunamis, wildfires and floods by proactively developing strong and enduring public/private partnerships for preparedness, response and recovery.

James is a familiar face and voice to many Oregonians when natural disasters strike, through his appearances on local radio and TV, but also has appeared nationally on The O'Reilly Factor, CNN, The CBS Evening News, NPR, and the Voice of America.

TECHNICAL SESSIONS

As always, the technical sessions are the focus of the conference and there is a terrific lineup to choose from. Informative sessions include pedestrian crossings, flood planning, signing and striping standards, a transportation funding strategies panel and bridge rehabilitation projects.

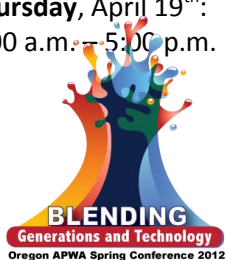
