Museum Tour On the University of Oregon Campus



Wear weather appropriate clothing. We may be walking 3 blocks, from the Museum of Natural and Cultural History to the Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art. (If you are not able to walk the distance or choose not too; a van will be available to drive you.)

Come with us on a tour of the Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art and the Museum of Natural and Cultural History. The University of Oregon's art museum opened its doors to the public on June 10, 1933. The museum was built to house the Murray Warner Collection of Oriental Art. Today, significantly expanded gallery space allows the museum to host concurrent collections installations as well as changing exhibitions. The Museum of Natural and Cultural History is Oregon's primary repository for anthropological and paleontological collections. This museum houses nearly 1 million ethnographic and archaeological objects and almost 100,000 fossils and biological specimens from Oregon, the Pacific Northwest, and around the world.

A van will pick you up in front of Valley River Inn at 1:00 p.m.. A host will be on this tour to give you some history on Eugene and the U of O campus. Our group will have a guided tour of each museum.
